1. <u>Stanford University Knight-Hennessy Scholars Program</u>

The Stanford University Knight-Hennessy Scholars Program is open for International Students. The scholarship allows masters, and Ph.D. level programs in the field of all subjects taught at Stanford University. During each of the first 3 years of graduate study, Knight-Hennessy Scholars receive a fellowship applied directly to cover tuition and associated fees and a stipend for living and academic expenses.

2. The Meta research PhD Fellowship Program

3. Schwarzman Scholars

Schwarzman Scholars was designed in collaboration with world-leading universities to create an international community that bridges differences. Schwarzman Scholars is a fully-funded, one-year master's degree and leadership program at Tsinghua University in Beijing, China. At the heart of the program are world-renowned advisers, a rigorous and innovative study of global affairs, and hands-on exploration of Chinese culture and commerce.
