# 1. Griffith Remarkable Scholarship

The Griffith Remarkable Scholarship rewards exceptional students applying for postgraduate coursework degree programs at Griffith University by covering 50% of their tuition fees. The scholarship is valid for your whole degree and you must be a citizen of a country other than Australia and New Zealand.

**Location:** Australia **Deadline:** 6th August 2021 **Eligibility:** Have a minimum GPA in previous studies of 5.5 or above on a 7 point scale or equivalent.

## 2. The Rhodes Scholarships for India

The Rhodes Scholarship is the oldest (first awarded in 1902) and perhaps most prestigious international scholarship programme, enabling outstanding young people from around the world to study at the University of Oxford.

Each year, there are five Scholarships available for India. The first Indian Rhodes Scholars took up residence in Oxford in 1947, and since that time over two hundred Indians have been awarded the Scholarship.

Location: United Kingdom Deadline: 2nd August 2021 Eligibility: You must have completed (or will have completed by June / July 2022) your undergraduate degree with First Class, or equivalent.

### 3. Skoltech Scholarships 2022 in Russia

**Eligibility:** The participants should have a First University Bachelor's Degree or equivalent. It is open to Graduates in the field of Social Sciences, Political Sciences, Law, Economics, and Public Administration.

## 6. Leap Scholarship

The Leap Scholar program is the most comprehensive counselling program in India designed to guide students in their college application process to universities and colleges abroad. Results of the Leap Scholarship will be declared after the admission results are declared by the colleges and universities.

#### Location: UK Deadline: 30th July 2021

#### **Eligibility:**

- CGPA of 6 or above.
- Must complete the college application process via LeapScholar Program.
- You must be applying to a university abroad for 2021 intake.
- You will not be eligible for Leap Scholarship if you're already receiving any other type of grant, reward or financial aid.
