

## **1. Sydney Scholars India Scholarship Program, University of Sydney, Australia**

The University of Sydney invites applications for Sydney Scholars India Scholarship Program 2021 open for all Indian students.

Total 28 scholarships will be awarded on an annual basis, consisting of:

- 3 scholarships: Undergraduate students for up to four years.
- 25 scholarships: First-year undergraduate and postgraduate students.

**Deadline:** 18th June 2021

**Eligibility:** Applicants commencing a second degree at the University of Sydney are eligible to apply, provided they have **not** previously held The Sydney Scholars India Scholarship

## **2. UWE Bristol Millennium Scholarship**

Bristol is welcoming applications for UWE Bristol Millennium Scholarship, June 2021 from students who wish to seek a postgraduate certificate at UWE. The grant includes the students to embrace temporary positions for working inside the global office/different divisions and attempt ambassadorial action for the college during the residency of the course. Those who choose understudies will get half educational expenses for one scholastic year.

## **3. University of Birmingham Global Masters Scholarship**

Global Masters Scholarship intends to support the most academically talented international students from across the world to Masters degrees during the 2021/22 academic year.

Approximately 30 scholarships will be awarded with a value of up to £10,000 GBP. This award will be deducted from the total tuition fees owed by each successful scholar.

All taught Masters' programs are eligible for this scholarship, with the exception of programs in the Birmingham Business School, for which there are separate MSc and MBA scholarships on offer.

**Location:** UK

**Deadline:** 30th June 2021

**Eligibility:**

In order to be eligible, candidates must meet the following requirements.

Candidates must:

- Have received, and accepted, an offer of admission for a taught Master's degree at the University of Birmingham UK Campus to study in the 2021/22 academic year.
- Start their studies at the University in September/ October 2021 on a course delivered on-campus.

#### **4. Rhodes Scholarship**

Rhodes scholarship is offered to Indian students looking to pursue postgraduate courses from the University of Oxford. This scholarship covers college fees and personal stipend and travel expenses. A total of five scholarships will be awarded to Indian students. Candidates are nominated by their university, approved by their state Rhodes committee, go through a state-level interview, and then a cocktail party and again pass a regional level interview.

**Deadline:** 31st July 2021

**Eligibility:**

- Indian Citizen
- Students have completed, or are in the final year of an undergraduate degree at a university in India.

The Marie-Skłodowska Curie Postdoctoral Fellowship (MSCA PF) is a post-doc training programme in which the post-doc (fellow) gains additional skills and abilities working on a specific research project in a new environment.

## **6. Leap Scholarship**

The Leap Scholar program is the most comprehensive counselling program in India designed to guide students in their college application process to universities and colleges abroad. Results of the Leap Scholarship will be declared after the admission results are declared by the colleges and universities.

**Location:** UK

**Deadline:** 30th July 2021

**Eligibility:**

- CGPA of 6 or above.
- Must complete the college application process via LeapScholar Program.
- You must be applying to a university abroad for 2021 intake.
- You will not be eligible for Leap Scholarship if you're already receiving any other type of grant, reward or financial aid.

## **7. Fulbright-Nehru Doctoral Research Fellowships**

The Fulbright-Nehru Doctoral Research Fellowships are designed for Indian scholars who are registered for a PhD at an Indian institution. These fellowships are for six to nine months. The applicant will be affiliated with one U.S. host institution for his/her grant.

**Location:** India

**Deadline:** 15th July 2021

**Eligibility:**

- The applicant should have done adequate research in the relevant field, especially in the identification of resources in India and the U.S. Applicants must be registered for Ph.D. at an Indian institution on or before November 2, 2020.
- The expected Ph.D. thesis submission date should at least be three months after the Fulbright-Nehru grant end date.

## **7. Internships at International Rice Research Institute (IRRI)**

IRRI has been working with partners in different countries to develop and operationalize satellite based rice monitoring systems (e.g., PRISM, <https://prism.philrice.gov.ph/>; RIICE, <http://www.riice.org/>). As part of on-going research, remote sensing is being used to further characterize rice-based systems and derive indicators for rice crop health and management. The following are the topics of interest to IRRI that can be done as part of the internship of MTech students (12-16 weeks) or further expanded as dual degree projects. Due to continued travel restrictions, the proposed research topics will involve deskwork using open source software, freely available satellite images, products derived from satellite and drone images, and ground observations collected by IRRI and partners in the Philippines.

Projects Titles:

- Detecting crop rotation and fallow duration using multi-temporal SAR and optical imagery
- Analysis of drone images to differentiate crop establishment methods
- Drone-based crop monitoring of bacterial leaf blight (BLB) progression at experimental fields at IRRI

**Location:** Philippines

**Deadline:** 15th June 2021

**Eligibility:**

- 3<sup>rd</sup> year B.Tech and 4<sup>th</sup> year DD
