

## May Newsletter

### **1. University of East Anglia, Norwich, United Kingdom**

International Undergraduate Scholarship is designed to reward applicants who have been offered a place to study with UEA and who can clearly and concisely explain how studying here at UEA will help them to make an outstanding contribution to their chosen field of study as well as the wider UEA community.

**Location:** UK

**Deadline:** 31st May 2021

**Eligibility:**

- Candidates must be possessing an unconditional or conditional offer for the first year of a UG degree program from the university.
- Candidates must be independently funded and must not be sponsored or recipients of any other scholarship.

### **2. British Council Great Scholarship**

India Postgraduate Scholarships are offered to international students who hold Indian citizenship and are enrolled in a postgraduate degree program at UEA.

Award Value:

£4,000 for the candidates who meet the entry requirements of the university

£5,000 for candidates with a final undergraduate grade of more than 65 percent

The amounts will be deducted from candidates' tuition fees for each year of the intended program at the university.

**Location:** UK

**Deadline:** 31st May 2021

**Eligibility:** Candidates must be applying for courses that are commencing in September.

### **3. Humber College, Toronto, Canada Scholarship**

#### **INTERNATIONAL ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIPS**

This entrance scholarship is available for Graduate Certificate, Diploma, and Advanced Diploma students joining Humber in May, September, and January.

This Scholarship incentive will equate to CAD \$2,000 off student's tuition fees over the course of their first year of studies.

**Location:** Canada

**Deadline:** 30th May 2021 (for September 2021 Semester)

**Eligibility:**

- Students with GPA 85%+ and 6.5+ IELTS (or equivalent in TOEFL, Duolingo, senior high school grade in English)
- Confirmed Letter of Acceptance from Humber College

### **4. University Of Westminster, London, United Kingdom Scholarship**

The scholarship provides a one-off £2,000 tuition fee award and is open to overseas fee-paying students with a minimum 2.1 UK degree equivalent. £2,000 Tuition Fee Award will be paid directly to the University towards your tuition fees in your first semester. Students on two-year postgraduate courses will receive the award for their first year only.

Selection is based on academic qualifications and personal statements.

**Location:** London

**Deadline:** 14th June 2021

**Eligibility:** All BSc and MSc students

### **5. Sydney Scholars India Scholarship Program**

The Sydney Scholars India Scholarships are awarded to exceptional international students. The Scholarship is open to all commencing Indian students enrolled full time in an undergraduate or postgraduate coursework degree.

This program intends to foster the engagement between the University and India in our investment in research, collaboration with industry partners and deepening the commitment to education for students to achieve their full potential.

**Location:** Sydney

**Deadline:** 18th June 2021

**Eligibility:** Applicants commencing a second degree at the University of Sydney are eligible to apply provided they have not previously held The Sydney Scholars India Scholarship.

## **6. University of Birmingham Global Masters Scholarship**

Global Masters Scholarship intends to support the most academically talented international students from across the world to Masters degrees during the 2021/22 academic year.

Approximately 30 scholarships will be awarded with a value of up to £10,000 GBP. This award will be deducted from the total tuition fees owed by each successful scholar.

All taught Masters' programs are eligible for this scholarship, with the exception of programs in the Birmingham Business School, for which there are separate MSc and MBA scholarships on offer.

**Location:** UK

**Deadline:** 30th June 2021

**Eligibility:**

In order to be eligible, candidates must meet the following requirements.

Candidates must:

- Have received, and accepted, an offer of admission for a taught Master's degree at the University of Birmingham UK Campus to study in the 2021/22 academic year.
- Start their studies at the University in September/ October 2021 on a course delivered on-campus.

## **7. Global Futures Scholarship**

**The University of Manchester**

This scholarship is open to both undergraduate and master's students holding an offer from The University of Manchester and evaluation will be based on academic merit and the quality of your scholarship application.

Ten awards of £6,000 will be allocated on the basis of academic excellence.

For the purposes of these awards, students will be considered from international fee-paying students domiciled in the following countries: Bangladesh, Nepal, India, Pakistan, or Sri Lanka.

**Location:** UK

**Deadline:** 20th May 2021.

**Eligibility:** Applicants for MBA, MPhil, Master of Architecture (MArch), Architecture and Urbanism (MA), and Master of Landscape Architecture (MLA)
