2. The Business School Executive Dean's Scholarship (International)

It will be applicable only for the first semester of study.

6. AAUW International Fellowships in the USA for Women (Masters/Ph.D./Postdoctoral)

AAUW (the American Association of University Women) awards International Fellowships for full-time study or research in the United States to women who are not United States citizens or permanent residents. Both graduate and postgraduate studies at accredited institutions are supported provided they have a language level of at least B2 (according to the European Language Portfolio Global Scale) in French or English depending on the language his/her masters is taught.

7. Swiss Government Excellence Scholarships for Foreign Students (Masters)

Each year, the Swiss Confederation awards Government Excellence Scholarships to promote international exchange and research cooperation between Switzerland and over 180 other countries. The research scholarship is available to postgraduate researchers in any discipline (who hold a master's degree as a minimum) who are planning to come to Switzerland to pursue research or further studies at the doctoral or postdoctoral level.
