### **1. Ph.D. scholarship: Combined Dynamic/Biaxial Compression Failure Mode of Geostructures**

The University of Queensland has opened a position for a full-time Ph.D. candidate for performing high-quality research in the field of rock testing and fracture mechanics. Dr. Mehdi Serati and Prof. David Williams of the Geotechnical Engineering Centre (GEC) within the school of Civil Engineering will be supervising the candidates. The Ph.D. candidate will be a part of a multidisciplinary team in partnership with the industry partners.

### **2. MBA Student Scholarship - International**

The business school of the University of Queensland is offering a 25% tuition fee waiver for outstanding students who are commencing their MBA studies. The scholarship will entitle the successful applicant to receive a 25% discount on their course tuition fees for a maximum period of 24 months. If the scholarship recipient exceeds the 24-month timeframe they become solely responsible for the full tuition cost of any and all remaining courses after the date specified in the scholarship offer.

### **3. Knight-Hennessy Scholars program**

The Knight-Hennessy Scholars program aims to develop both the depth and range of subject expertise to confront the intractable challenges and opportunities of the future. The selected scholars will be a part of a unique community of change agents from a diverse range of backgrounds. All this would make the scholars better leaders who would be having a multidisciplinary and multicultural understanding of the problems that the world is facing in the present day i.e. environment, healthcare, education, inequality, and social justice.

#### 4. Graduate Research Scholarships

Graduate Research Scholarships are awarded to students based on academic merit. The applications are evaluated based on the applicant's research potential in that work area and his/her performance in the last completed degree. Several other factors like relevant professional experience, specialist medical qualifications, refereed publications may also be taken into consideration. There is 100% fee remission up to \$110,000. Approximately 600 scholarships will be awarded.

**Deadline:** 31st October 2020

**Eligibility:** Students aspiring for a graduate research degree.

#### 5. India Global Leaders Scholarship

The India Global Leaders Scholarship is available to Indian students to continue their studies in fields of Business, Economics and Law. Tuition fee offset ranging \$5000 - \$20,000 would be awarded to the scholars. The final amount will be at the discretion of their selection committee. This scholarship is available only to those Indian students, who are currently residing in India and are not pursuing any other degree in Australia. It will be applicable only for the first semester of study.

**Deadline:** 30th November, 2020

**Eligibility:** Students aspiring for Postgraduate degree in Business/Economics/Law.

#### 6. The Business School Executive Dean's Scholarship (International)

This scholarship is applicable for students applying for a full-time Master's degree within the Business School of Bournemouth University. There will be a 50% fees waiver. It will be awarded in the students' first year only, unless stated otherwise. This scholarship is applicable for courses starting in January 2021. The university reserves the right to withdraw or amend the scholarships at any point of time.

## 7. DAAD-Wise Research Internship

This program targets Indian students pursuing a degree in the fields of science and engineering who wish to do a research internship at a publicly-funded German higher education institution or a research institute in Germany. They may choose to work under doctoral students, scientists, or professors as a part of their ongoing research projects. A monthly scholarship of 750 Euros and travel subsidy of 1050 Euros will be provided to the students.

**Deadline:** 1st November, 2020

**Eligibility:** IIT-KGP students who are currently in the 5th, 6th semester of a B-Tech. degree or in 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th semester of a Dual-Degree (B-Tech.+M-Tech.) course.

## 8. Joint Ph.D Program for fresh doctoral students of IIT Kharagpur or University of Auckland

The joint doctoral student will pursue their research under the supervision of academics in both institutions and will split their time between the two campuses. Doctoral candidates will have access to opportunities at both institutions, whether it is related to their research programme or their professional development. A single thesis will be submitted at the end which will be examined by both institutions, and if accepted by both, the student will be awarded a testamur bearing the seals of IIT Kharagpur and the University of Auckland.
