1. Facebook Fellowship Program 2022

Facebook Fellowship Program 2022 has been announced to encourage and support promising doctoral students who are engaged in innovative and relevant research in areas related to computer science and engineering at an accredited university. Those who get selected for the fellowship will be given two years of paid tuition and fees, a \$42,000 annual stipend to cover living and conference travel costs, a paid visit to Facebook headquarters for the annual fellowship Summit, and various opportunities to engage with Facebook researchers.

Location: USA

Deadline: 20th September 2021 PST

Eligibility: Applicants must be full-time PhD students who are enrolled in a recognised university

2. Globalink Research Internship 2022

Mitacs Globalink Research Internship is a competitive initiative for international undergraduates. Top-ranked applicants participate in a 12-week research internship under the supervision of Canadian university faculty members in a variety of academic disciplines, from science, engineering, and mathematics to the humanities and social sciences.

Location: Canada

Deadline: 22nd September 2021

Eligibility: Have one to three semesters remaining in an undergraduate program

3. Stanford University Knight-Hennessy Scholars Program

Stanford University Knight-Hennessy Scholars Program is open for international students. The scholarship allows Masters, PhD level programme(s) in all fields of study taught at Stanford University.

During each of the first 3 years of graduate study, Knight-Hennessy Scholars receive:

- A fellowship is applied directly to cover tuition and associated fees.

- There is a stipend for living and academic expenses (such as room and board, books, academic supplies, instructional materials, local transportation, and reasonable personal expenses).

Location: USA

Deadline: 6th October 2021

Eligibility: A U.S. bachelor's degree or its equivalent from a college or university of recognized standing.

4. Netherlands HAN Scholarships

The scholarship allows Masters level program(s) in all fields of study taught at HAN University of Applied Sciences. Under the HAN Scholarships, the selected students will be given € 7,500 – € 12,500 towards conducting master degree study at HAN University.

Location: Netherland

Deadline: 01st October 2021.

Eligibility:

- Not previously enrolled in a degree at a university or university of applied sciences in the Netherlands
- Accepted into a full-time English-taught degree program at HAN
- IELTS score of at least 6.5, a TOEFL iBT score of at least 90 or a Cambridge Certificate (CAE or CPE)

5. MBA Student Scholarship - International

The business school of the University of Queensland is offering a 25% tuition fee waiver for outstanding students who are commencing their MBA studies. The scholarship will entitle the successful applicant to receive a 25% discount on their course tuition fees for a maximum period of 24 months. If the scholarship recipient exceeds the 24-month timeframe they become solely responsible for the full tuition cost of any and all remaining courses after the date specified in the scholarship offer.

Location: Australia

Deadline: 31st October 2021

Eligibility: Students aspiring for an MBA

6. UNIL Master's Grants

The University of Lausanne in Switzerland offers the UNIL Master's Grants on a competitive basis to international students who wish to pursue a Master's Degree at the University. The scholarship is granted for the minimum statutory period of the programme chosen by the student. It amounts to CHF 1,600 per month from 15 September to 15 July (or 10 months a year) for the complete duration of the masters.

Location: Switzerland

Deadline: 1st November 2021.

Eligibility: To have a language level of at least B2 (according to the European Language Portfolio global scale) in French or English

7. Graduate Research Scholarships

Graduate Research Scholarships are awarded to students based on academic merit. The applications are evaluated based on the applicant's research potential in that work area and his/her performance in the last completed degree. Several other factors like relevant professional experience, specialist medical qualifications, referred publications may also be taken into consideration. There is a 100% fee remission of up to \$110,000. Approximately 600 scholarships will be awarded.

Location: Australia

Deadline: 31st December 2021

Eligibility: Meet the entry requirements for a graduate research degree at the University of Melbourne, or be currently enrolled in a graduate research degree at the University of Melbourne

8. President's PhD Scholarships

Imperial College London offers 50 fully-funded awards in the form of President's PhD Scholarships to the students who want to pursue research at the college. This competitive scheme has higher than usual eligibility requirements, attracting candidates that show excellent academic performance and promising research potential.

Location: London

Deadline: 5th November 2021

Eligibility:

- Must have a first-class UK degree or its equivalent international degree.
- The student with multiple master's degrees, the degree relevant to their research studies must have a distinction.

9. Banting Postdoctoral Fellowships

Aiming to retain top-tier postdoctoral talent both nationally and internationally, Banting Postdoctoral Fellowships are awarded to students contributing to Canada's economic, social and research-based growth through a research-intensive career.

Location: Canada

Deadline: 22nd September 2021

Eligibility:

- Fulfilled all degree requirements for PhD, PhD equivalent or health professional degree
- Degree must be completed between September 15, 2018, and September 30, 2022, and before the start of their award
