1. Globalink Research Internship 2022

Mitacs Globalink Research Internship is a competitive initiative for international undergraduates. Top-ranked applicants participate in a 12-week research internship under the supervision of Canadian university faculty members in a variety of academic disciplines, from science, engineering, and mathematics to the humanities and social sciences.

Location: Canada.

Eligibility: Have one to three semesters remaining in an undergraduate program.

2. Stanford University Knight-Hennessy Scholars Program

The Stanford University Knight-Hennessy Scholars Program is open to International Students. The scholarship allows master's, and Ph.D. level programs in the field of all subjects taught at Stanford University. During each of the first 3 years of graduate study, Knight-Hennessy Scholars receive a fellowship applied directly to cover tuition and associated fees and a stipend for living and academic expenses.

Location: USA

Eligibility: U.S. bachelor's degree or its equivalent from a university of recognized standing.

3. Facebook Fellowship Program

The Facebook Fellowship is a global program designed to encourage and support promising doctoral students who are engaged in innovative and relevant research in areas related to computer science and engineering at an accredited university. Applications are evaluated based on the strength of the student's research statement, publication record, and recommendation letters.

Location: USA

Eligibility: Ph.D. students of CSE

4. Visiting Ph.D. fellowship

It allows registered Ph.D. students to utilize resources and facilities at UNU-WIDER for research in various areas. During their time in Helsinki, fellows prepare one or more research papers and present a seminar on their research findings. They may also have the opportunity to publish their research in the Wider Working Papers. The internship is for a period of 3 months.

Location: Finland

Eligibility: Applicants must be enrolled in a Ph.D. program.

6. OIST Research Internship Program Description

The OIST Graduate School offers education and research opportunities through our Research Intern program in STEM fields. The duration of the internship is typically from 2 to 6 months. Interns will work under the direction of a Professor and contribute to the research activities of OIST.

Location: Okinawa, Japan

Eligibility:

- Final 2 years of the undergraduate or Masters's programs in universities
- Currently, enrolled students must have approval from their home institution.
- The academic background of applicants should be appropriate to their desired host unit(s) at OIST.

7. Schwarzman Scholars

Schwarzman Scholars was designed in collaboration with world-leading universities to create an international community that bridges differences. Schwarzman Scholars is a fully-funded, one-year master's degree and leadership program at Tsinghua University in Beijing, China. At the heart of the program are world-renowned advisers, a rigorous and innovative study of global affairs, and a hands-on exploration of Chinese culture and commerce.

Location: China

Eligibility: One must be a native English speaker or have studied for at least two years in English during an undergraduate or graduate degree program.

Deadline: 20th September 2022

8. Graduate Research Scholarships

Graduate Research Scholarships are awarded to students based on academic merit. The applications are evaluated based on the applicant's research potential in that work area and his/her performance in the last completed degree. There is a 100% fee remission of up to \$110,000. Approximately 600 scholarships will be awarded.

Location: Australia

Eligibility: Meet the entry requirements for a graduate research degree at the University of Melbourne, or be currently enrolled in a graduate research degree at the University of Melbourne.
