2. The lessons we take from obstacles we encounter can be fundamental to later success. Recount a time when you faced a challenge, setback, or failure. How did it affect you, and what did you learn from the experience? Over the time, I realized that having more fun in doing any activities makes you more successful. It took me couple of years to understand that I am missing fun in doing my activities. I excelled in school and on standardized tests but there was always a part of me that felt like a failure because I couldn't live up to my Parents' expectations or desire for me to be more outgoing. I felt pressure to change and I tried to change but I could never really become more extroverted. It was my first major challenge that I encountered till Intermediate schooling. In 2013, as per the recommendation by my best friend, I started watching TED Talks show and following few Bloggers like Steve Goodier. It helped me to understand situations with others perspective. I learnt that all parents want the best for their kids. Likewise, I realize that my parents have been actualizing their own plan for my future where my job in life is to be the main character in their movie, but instead of playing character in someone else movie, I need to shoot my own movie portraying both as main character and director. I started focussing on the learning process, not on the outcome and stopped worrying as thinking the same negative thoughts would have only made me fall into bad mental habits. Eventually, I started quietly leading those around me through mentorship, encouragement, wisdom and inspiration. During my working period at TCS, I realized that world is so big. Another major challenge, I faced was to cope up with the pace of the work and business flow in world. After 1 years of taking up my responsibilities, I realized that most of my teams were unwilling to work separately in productivity improvement. I was receiving multiple follow-up e-mails demanding an explanation for marginal productivity improvement. But instead of sharing the defaulting teams' name, I took ownership of the failure on myself and kept on promising the manager that I would work hard with the teams to improve the situation. Contrary to my expectations, things almost got out of control, and then I decided to escalate against these teams. But it was too late. By that time, the Manager had already lost faith and believe in me. In a meeting, my manager not only detailed my failures and its impacts on client engagements but also stated that all your hard work will not be counted as your effort if you are not able to deliver expected result before deadline. I felt undignified and offered to move out from the current project and the team. Later, I got opportunity to work with different clients and team that seem to be very co-operative. This experience was a huge blow to my self-confidence but it taught me two great lessons: being assertive when required and allocating responsibilities to all. Last year, a similar situation occurred, but this time, I did not hesitate to warn the manager who took proactive steps to steer the guilty into place. Thus, the single setback/failure that I faced in my professional life taught me valuable team-working skills which I am now practicing successfully.
