6. Migration of Professionals like doctors, engineers and teachers to foreign country: According to the study from last few decades about the migration of people from their own country to other country in search of greener pastures shows that most of the migrants are skilled professionals like doctors, engineers and teachers. This causes a severe lack of talent in their own country. This is due to the lack of employment opportunities and other facilities like health, accommodation, job security, etc. Due to migrations of these types of skilled manpower hits the country in bad ways like slow development and economic crisis. This essay highlights the sluggish economy as major problem caused the movement of skilled manpower and mentions that provisions of an enhanced amenities. Nowadays, one of the biggest problems that country face is the shortage of skilled manpower but people are not stopping to migrate from their native country to foreign countries and this has been a common practice among the young ones. And most of them are proper skilled professionals. Nepal, for example produces hundreds of doctors and engineers each year and most of them migrate to other countries. Consequently, the country does not have sufficient doctors to treat its patients, does not sufficient engineers to build the sustainable infrastructures and even less teachers to educate the students. This is due to the problem faced by them in their own nation like, no job opportunities for doctors and engineers, less satisfaction of salaries etc. Migration of people has affected their native nations in a very bad way like severe lack of skilled personals to enhance the development process which has diminished the rate of development process which causes non reliable development leading to big economy crisis. These practices are making poor countries even poorer. However, problem stated in above paragraph can be solved by the government of their countries by providing better opportunities, good health and education facilities, better job security etc. Government can help the migrating manpower to remain and work in their own country by introducing different policies like providing free educations to the families of the skilled personals (like doctors), by giving stipends to them and as well as salaries on time, also by recognizing their achievements and providing awards for their contribution in their respective fields, so that they (doctors, teachers and engineers) can have better job satisfaction. For example, in case of teachers the respective school/college can provide them salary on time and also can award them on any annual programmes for their outstanding contributions. Also, students can be asked to give good reviews So that teachers can feel satisfied about their job. Most importantly, they should be respected by the surroundings so that they choose to stay in their own country. To conclude, when skilled manpower migrates to other countries, they create a huge shortage of talent in their native country. The one- and only-way government can end this practice is to provide better job opportunities, health services in their own country.
