I am happy to inform you that there were 66 international PhD applicants this year, and after a rigorous selection process, 7 have been offered admission. Of these, 6 have already enrolled, and one is pending registration because of financial difficulties.

This is the first time in recent years that our doctoral program is going to have this kind of international presence.

Out of the seven, three have scholarships from their own govts or from GoI, and four applicants have requested Institute scholarship at par with Indian doctoral students. The details of the four students are given below.
