

We are the research scholars selected for the IIT Kharagpur – University of Manchester Joint Doctoral Program.

We are currently doing the coursework and in discussion about the project with our respective supervisors, but very much worried about the **limited time (2021-2025)** we have for the completion of our Ph.D., given the situation.

- The work is mostly experimental, which would require us to get acquainted with the equipment, lab environment and it would be helpful if we can get an early head start.
- Along with coursework, we believe we must manage time to start introductory work, which would eventually help us in accumulating reasonable amount of content before our departure to the University of Manchester (**expected to be around August next year**)
- Apart from project work, we must go through courses, comprehensive exam, travel preparations (twice in 4years), and various other formalities and adjustments, which we fear would consume a good lot of time of the stipulated 4years.

Keeping the above points in mind, after thorough discussions with our respective supervisors, we realized that our return to campus is crucial now for the successful completion of the work, in the given timeframe. **With their consent (respective supervisors in CC), we kindly request your permission to stay inside the campus and access the laboratory abiding by the covid protocols and start our work.**

We are willing to provide the necessary undertaking from our supervisors and guardians whenever needed. **Added to that, all of us are doubly vaccinated right now.**

We will forever remain grateful if you kindly consider our situation and please let us know.
