We are a team of four undergraduates who recently represented IIT Kharagpur at the Hult Prize, a global forum for social entrepreneurship.

Our team, GrameenSetu, won the campus round held at IIT Kharagpur (38 participating teams). We then went on to participate in the Hult Prize regional round hosted in Dhaka from 27-29 May, consisting of teams from across Asia. We're happy to announce that our team was declared the winner amongst 62 shortlisted teams and has now qualified for the **Hult Prize Global Accelerator 2022** with a chance to win **USD 1 million** prize money.

Hult Prize is a prestigious annual global competition that challenges university students to solve the planet's most pressing issues through social entrepreneurship. This year's theme for the Hult Prize was "Bringing the World Back to Work". More details about the

Through GrameenSetu, we aim to empower the rural self-help groups by facilitating collaboration among themselves and connecting them with the semi-urban & urban markets through a portal that brings efficient communication, convenient contracting, tech-based quality check, and safe payment & invoicing, and stakeholders' feedback, all in one place.

The Global Accelerator is a very prestigious competition and it would be a proud moment for us to represent IIT Kharagpur at the event and be among only **16 teams globally selected**. We wish to apply for a grant to cover our travel expenses, giving us a chance to travel to Boston for the event and have an opportunity to win the \$1 Million prize, in an event, whose finale will be graced by the presence of the former American President, **Mr. Bill Clinton**.
