**Subj: Request for approval for signing the MoU with Georgia Institute of Technology (Georgia Tech)**







**Action Items:**

1. New MoU with Georgia Tech : Prof. Anandaroop Bhattacharya, ME

**Resolution:** This draft has been principally approved by the MoU committee. It was recommended to be placed for signatures.

2. New Joint Certification Course Georgia Tech: Prof. Anandaroop Bhattacharya, ME

**Resolution:** Though the committee members agreed in principle with the content of the draft, before it was processed further, the committee requested Dean FoEA, Prof. Ramgopal Maddali to review the draft Agreement. It was decided that if there were no further comments or concerns, then the draft would be placed in the Senate for discussions thereafter.

3. MoU with L&T: Prof. Surjya Kanta Pal, ME

**Resolution:** The draft MoU was approved in-principle. However, the Deputy Director, Chairman- MoU committee, advised the following input on Clause 5(c) of the document from the Audit Section:

- Whether the term, 'living expenses' could be used unambiguously in the document keeping in mind audit restrictions/protocols/rules etc.?
- If not, whether the term 'pocket allowances' could be used to supplement the word 'living expenses'.

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

**The Board of Regents of the  
University System of Georgia by and on behalf of  
Georgia Institute of Technology  
and  
Indian Institute of Technology, Kharagpur**

This Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) is made and effective as of \_\_\_\_\_ (“Effective Date”) by and between **The Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia by and on behalf of Georgia Institute of Technology** (“Georgia Tech”) having its principal offices located at 225 North Avenue, Atlanta, GA 30332 and **Indian Institute of Technology, Kharagpur** (“IITKGP”) having its principal offices located at IIT Kharagpur Campus, Kharagpur, Dist – Midnapore (W), West Bengal 721302.

Georgia Tech and IITKGP are sometimes hereinafter individually referred to as “Party” and collectively referred to as “Parties.”

**WHEREAS**, Georgia Tech and IITKGP have complementary interests and have the present intent to enter into discussions between authorized representatives to establish specific research, education, and financial arrangements, which may lead to opportunities of mutual benefit; and

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Parties agree as follows:

**1. Areas of Cooperation.** The Parties agree to explore the possibilities of cooperation in the following general areas:

- Faculty exchange
- Student exchange
- Exchange of scientific and teaching materials
- Joint research projects
- Joint Certification courses
- Dual/Joint degree programmes
- Conferences/Workshops/Symposia

**2. Research Collaboration.** Georgia Tech and IITKGP will initiate collaborative activities contingent upon successful negotiation and execution of appropriate agreements at a later date, which shall outline the terms and conditions applicable to each activity, and as Georgia Tech is permitted under U.S. export laws and regulations, and as IITKGP is permitted under the laws, rules, regulations and policies of Govt. of India and its Ministry of Education. The Parties understand and agree that the Georgia Tech Research Corporation is a cooperative organization of Georgia Tech and shall enter into any research agreements on behalf of Georgia Tech. Similarly, the office of Sponsored Research and Industrial Consultancy (SRIC) at IITKGP shall enter into research agreements on behalf of IITKGP.

Joint research projects may be explored by appropriate faculty members with the approval of the Parties according to the established procedures at each institution.

**3. Confidentiality.** Proprietary or confidential information may be exchanged between the Parties once a mutually agreeable written nondisclosure agreement has been executed between the Parties and export approval has been obtained, if applicable.

outside Georgia Tech, and likewise IITKGP's degree granting powers does not extend to or include Georgia Tech or any students outside IITKGP.

- e. This MOU shall extend from the Effective Date and continue for a period of five (5) years. This MOU may be revised or renewed by mutual written consent of the Parties.
- f. Either Party may terminate this MOU upon six (6) months' written notice. In the event of termination, participating students in any educational programs of the Parties at such a time shall be permitted to complete their activities in accordance with the terms of this MOU.
- g. This MOU is written in English and may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original but all of which shall constitute one and the same instrument. Facsimile or electronic signature copies shall be deemed original for all purposes.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties have caused this MOU to be duly executed as of the Effective Date by their duly authorized representatives.
