Subject: Financial Support for IITKGP-University of Manchester Joint Doctoral Student Ms. Juhi Srivastava

Ms. Juhi Srivastava was recommended for admission in the Department of Metallurgical and Materials Engg. IIT Kharagpur in the Autumn semester of 2021-22 and was awarded a Partial Scholarship which includes full tuition waiver during her 12 month stay at University of Manchester, and payment of Institute Fellowship at prevailing rates during her stay at IIT Kharagpur. According to the terms of her scholarship, Juhi would be required to cover her living expenses and other incidental fees during her stay at University of Manchester.

Ms. Juhi Srivastava left for University of Manchester on the Sept 23, 2022.

Ms. Srivastava subsequently obtained a partial funding of GBP 6000/annum from her host mentor at Manchester. In addition, Mr. Mukund Padmanabhan, esteemed alum of IITKGP, has very kindly extended support to Juhi with USD 10,000, to cover her living expenses while at Manchester.

Juhi is currently in Manchester, and her supervisors have expressed a requirement for her to continue her stay in Manchester from September 2023 to September 2024 in order to work on her project.

As mentioned above, Juhi has been receiving a stipend of £800 per month from the GKF fund since Sept 2023 and an additional £500 per month from the Airbus project for the period spanning September 2022 to September 2023 in Manchester. (B)

During the 2nd year of her stay at Manchester between September 2023 to September 2024, her host mentor has agreed to increase the stipend to £800 per month. Living in Manchester requires a minimum of £1,300 per month, and despite the above mentioned support, Juhi is falling short of £500. **She is therefore requesting that IITKGP provides her the support of £500/month for the upcoming year during September 2023-August 2024.** (A)

I am enrolled in a dual award Ph.D. program, which requires me to spend my first year at IIT Kharagpur and the second year in UoM. The remaining two years are to be divided equally between Manchester and IIT Kharagpur, depending on the nature of my research. Having successfully completed my first year in IIT Kharagpur, I arrived in Manchester for my second year in September 2022. During the initial 4 to 5 months, I completed my training to gain access to the required equipment for my research. I have recently commenced my primary experiment, the 4-point bend test. To ensure a comprehensive understanding and obtain accurate results, I will need sufficient time to complete this critical phase.

It is imperative for the success of my research project that I am granted permission to stay in Manchester from September 2023 to September 2024 with financial support. I would like to mention that I am currently receiving a stipend of £800 per month from the Alumni fund and an additional £500 per month from the Airbus project for the period spanning September 2022 to September 2023 in Manchester. For the upcoming academic year, from September 2023 to September 2024, I will receive £800 per month from the Airbus project while residing in Manchester. In addition, I request financial assistance of £500 per month from IIT Kharagpur to meet the expenses for staying in Manchester. 





Dear Mukund,

Thank you for your generosity!

The current plan is to give \$10k to Juhi in two installments. The first one may be immediate while the second installment may be given after a semester upon receipt of her performance evaluation report from her supervisor. We will send the report to you for final approval after our preliminary review.

For Mr Samarakoon we will look into the situation after every semester. Currently the economic and political situation in Sri Lanka is not well (1 Sri Lankan Rupee = 0.22 INR) and the help given to him may be considered as exceptional because we do not want to set this as a precedence. If the economic situation improves then we may not continue giving him the stipend any more. In the worst case, however, we can support him at most for five years or the duration of his PhD, whichever is lesser. Assuming the worst case scenario we would like to keep \$13.5k booked for him.

I would like to hear your opinion on this plan. So \$23.5k of \$25k is booked if this works.
