International Relations Student Cell (IRSC), which is the student body working under the Office of AA&IR have been operating the Foreign Training Program (FTP) for the past several years. The FTP is a student led initiative where research projects are requested from distinguished Professors from renowned global universities (WUR 500) to provide IITKGP students with an enriching opportunity to engage themselves in collaborative research internships. The program has seen a substantial growth over the years and a tremendous response from faculty members world-wide resulting in over 150 projects from prestigious institutions such as Stanford University, Imperial College London, Hong Kong University of Science and Technology, to name a few.

FTP offers the following leverage to IITKGP and its students:

- international exposure
- enriching experience of scholarly learning
- open opportunities for foreign collaboration

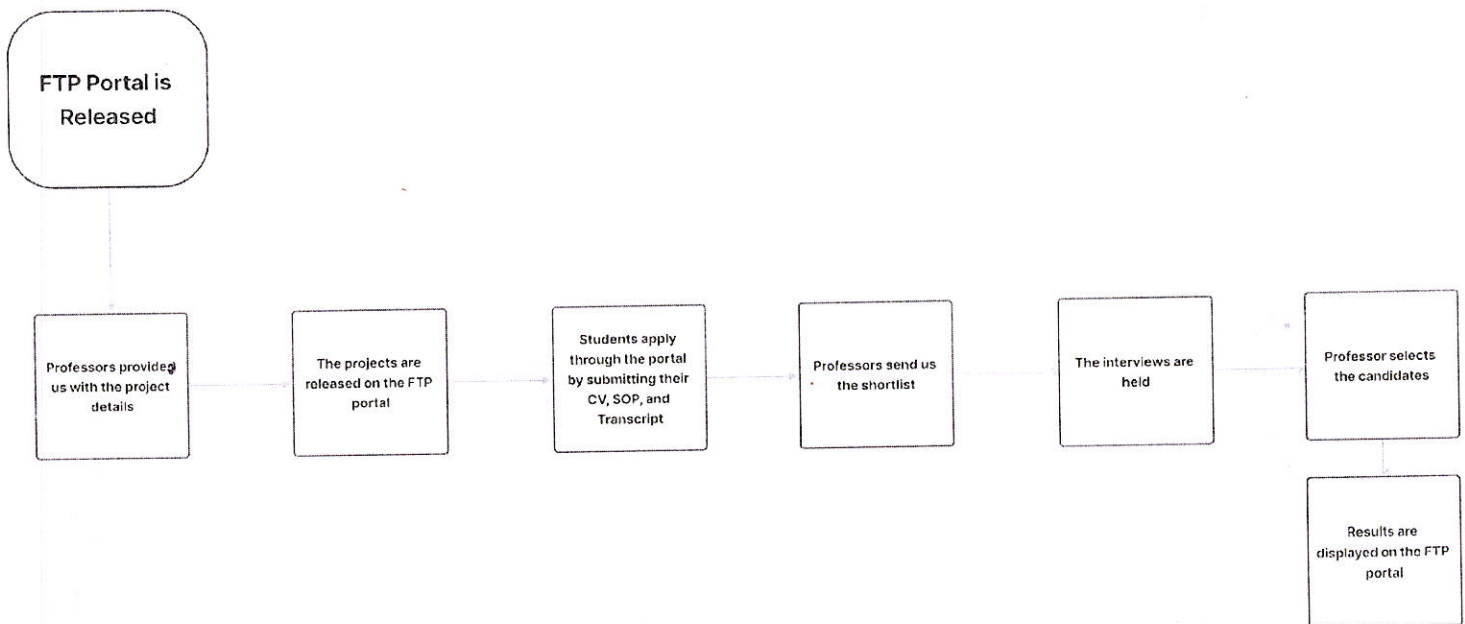
Foreign Training Portal

International Relations Cell of IIT Kharagpur is a student body working under the esteemed guidance of the Office of International Relations which operates under Associate Dean, Alumni Affairs and International Relations and Dean, Outreach and Alumni Affairs, IIT Kharagpur. We are keen on building our relations with universities abroad on our initiatives. We provide the esteemed professors of host university with brilliant students of IIT Kharagpur who can actively contribute to their research projects.

Foreign Training Program for the academic session 2023-24 is an independent venture wherein distinguished Professors from renowned global universities provide our students with an invaluable opportunity to engage themselves in collaborative research internships. In the preceding iteration of this program, we received a remarkable response, with over 150 projects pouring in from prestigious institutions such as Stanford University, Imperial College London, Hong Kong University of Science and Technology, and many more.

A brief Work Flow:

- The professors provide us with the project details.
- The project is released on our portal, and the students apply for the projects by submitting a Statement of Purpose, Grade Transcript, and Curriculum Vitae (CV). We then forward it to the professor, and they shortlist the students.
- The Professor sends us the shortlist, and we coordinate video/telephonic interviews of students with the Professor if they are willing to do so.
- The Professor then selects students based on their merits and sends us their names.
- The selected students work with the professor from May to July of the following year (2024 in this case).

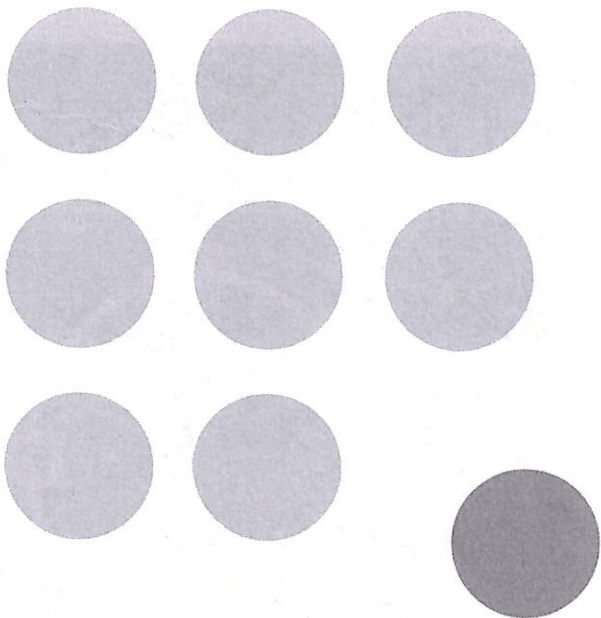

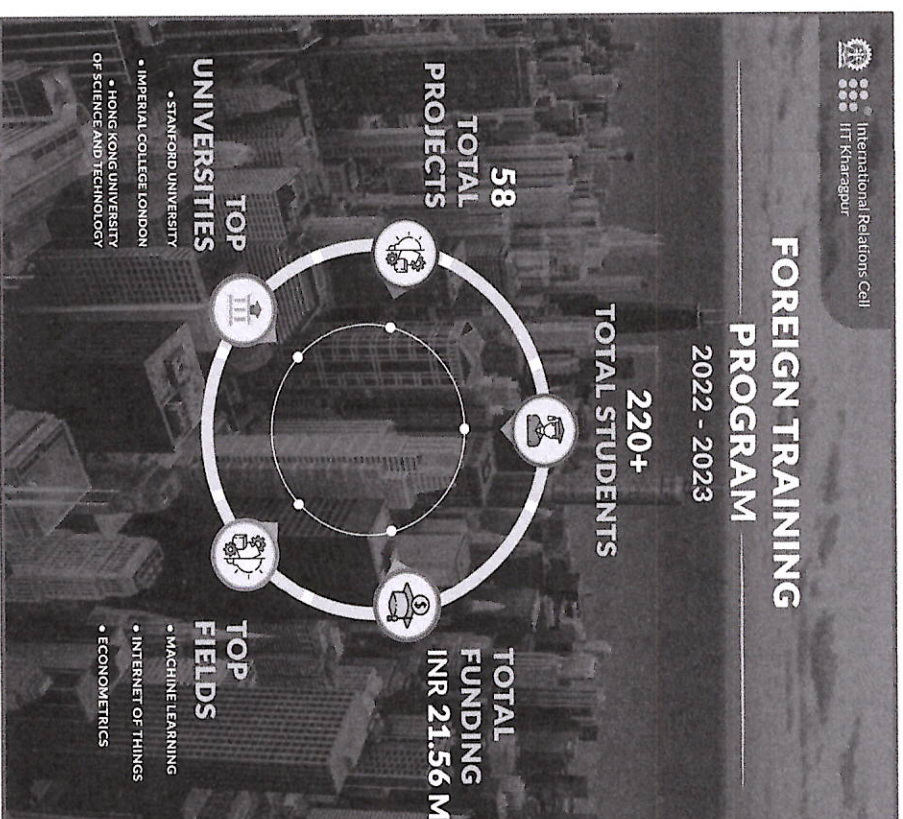
Foreign Training Program

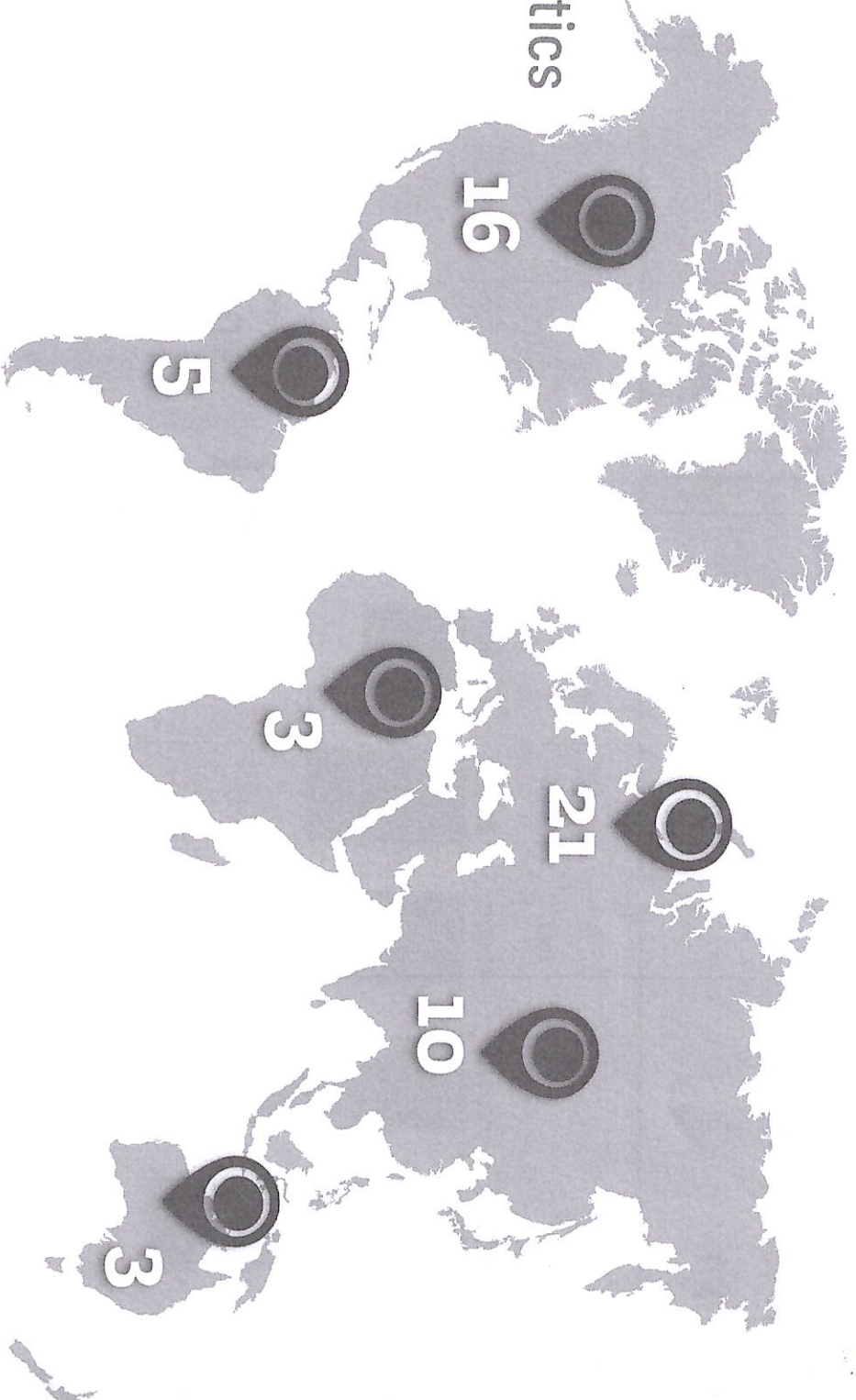

FTP Continent Wise Statistics



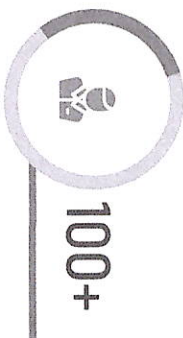

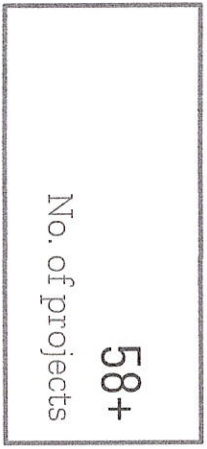
Foreign Training Program 2022-2023



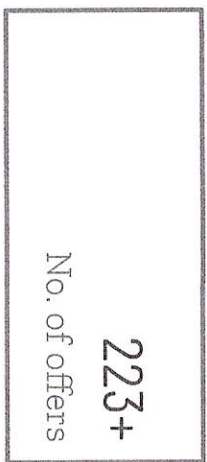
