The Guru Kripa Foundation, represented by Dr. Mukund Padmanabhan, an alumnus of IIT Kharagpur, provides educational opportunities to deserving individuals, through educational scholarships.

IIT Kharagpur advertises each year for application of Summer Student Fellowships from its Undergraduate and Post Graduate Students, particularly from the Dept. of Electronics & Electrical Communication Engineering. The foundation typically sets up an application and selection process for scholarships. Students interested in applying for scholarships provided by Guru Kripa Foundation are required to submit their applications along with relevant documents, such as academic records, offer letters, and recommendation letters. The IITKGP and the Foundation jointly reviews the applications and selects the recipients based on the predetermined criteria.

In 2023, 12 IITKGP students were awarded scholarship from the GKF (Flag 1).

This year, the call for application need to be released by 15<sup>th</sup> of February with a deadline for application in March. 

The above decisions were arrived based on the following principles:


- Students from ECE dept. were given highest priority in the mandatory internship category.
- Mandatory internships was given priority over optional internships.
- In both mandatory as well as optional internship categories the students were ranked according to CGPA.
- Partial funding was given precedence over fully funded applications
- 2 students were chosen from the incomplete application category because of their high CGPA. These students (Anirban and Apoorv) were chosen because their application was otherwise complete except submission of Letter of Recommendation (LoR)
- 2 Students ( Tushar andVashu) were selected as waitlisted because their CGPA was above 7.5 but under 8.0
- Mr. Abhishek Banerjee's application is provisionally approved and pending final approval. Since he is from the defense background, his final approval is contingent upon clearance from his employer.
- Mr. Rounak Mondal's application is provisionally approved and pending final approval which is contingent upon his submission of LoR.

The committee further requests that the wait-listed candidates be considered for scholarship by GKIF, if circumstances permit.
